Absentee Bidding Terms

Absentee bids, whether written, phoned or faxed, are accepted as legal and binding contracts to purchase the described items.

Turn on to America is not responsible for bidder's errors on the bid forms and the absentee bidder will be considered the purchaser.

Unless directed otherwise, each successful absentee bidder's credit card will be charged for those items successfully bid upon, on the day of notification, including a voice mail or e-mail message left by T.O.T.A. Shipment will not be made until payment has been received. Items must be picked or shipping arranged within 3 business days.

Anyone of good creditworthiness, acceptable to the auctioneer, including the auction staff, may submit an absentee bid; however, it is up to the sole discretion of the auctioneer whether to accept a bid or not. In the event that an absentee or phone representative fails to execute an absentee or phone bid (regardless of reason) the representative and/or T.O.T.A. will not be held responsible for any actual or imagined losses incurred.

At the auction, bids are handled in a competitive manner in an attempt to buy the object for less than your top bid. You will pay one bid above the next highest bid, increments to be determined by the auctioneer, but no more than your maximum. If two absentee bids are received with the exact same amount, the first bid received will take precedence. Absentee bids have an equal chance of being successful, as do telephone or in-person bids, yet do not take precedence over any other bidding method.

In general, bids usually start with the live audience. However, if the floor does not open the bidding at a reasonable amount, the absentee bid staff person has the discretion to open the item at 50% of the absentee bidder's maximum bid or at the minimum reserve on said item.
